Strip Piecing Magic: Squares-on-Point and Flying Geese

One Day / Process Oriented Confident Beginner-Advanced

Make 'Squares-On-Point' any size including miniature without, paper, templates, waste or problems with the bias. Then use a rotary cutter like a magic wand and turn the squares into Flying Geese. Combine rows of geese to make a variety of unique patterns to use for borders, blocks, quilts and garments. TUBULAR STRIP PIECING method is a cross between Seminole and Bargello. Samples and 'eye candy' will spark your creativity into using this old favorite in new ways. Process oriented class.
