Inventive, bias friendly, tubular strip-piecing process makes rows of Flying Geese any size without paper, templates or waste. Combine rows to make a variety of unique patterns. Rita guides you through her design process to work in colorways to build patterns and 'geese' quilt components for a small quilt. Methods for sizing and manipulating geese will be covered in this project oriented class. Simple formula and technique is a cross between Seminole and Bargello with a unique twist. Techniques learned will greatly enhance your quilting vocabulary. Rita comes with lots of 'eye candy' that will spark your creativity into using this old favorite in new ways.
